- The conference is intended for senior students, graduates, alumni, PhD students, and young scholars.
- The languages of the conference are all the Slavonic languages and English.
- Time given to the paper presentation: 15–20 minutes.

The presentations will be divided into sections according to their topics. These sections will be conducted by the members of academia of the Charles University. Participants in the conference presenting a paper will be offered to publish their contribution in a form of comprehensive study in conference proceedings. Editors of the volume reserve the right to reject contributions not conforming with requirements put on scientific texts (regarding content, language, or formal side).
